

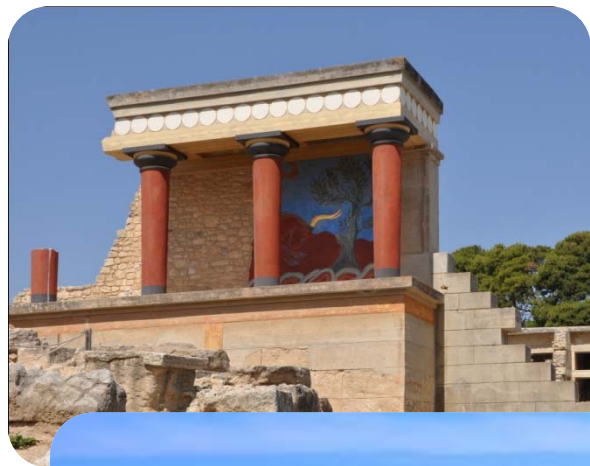

The 26th EWAPS Workshop will be held in Crete, at **St Nicolas Bay Resort Hotel** (<http://www.stnicolasbay.gr>).

Day 1

Wednesday 20th June 2012

Day 2

Thursday 21st June 2012

Boat trip to **Spinalonga** and dinner under the candlelight at a fish tavern in **Plaka, Elounda**.



Originally, Spinalonga was not an island, but part of the island of Crete. During Venetian occupation the island was carved out of the coast for defense purposes and a fort was built.

The island has also been used as a leper colony. Spinalonga has appeared in novels, as well as television series and films.

Friday 22nd June 2012

Trip to the **Palace of Knossos** and dining at the traditional Cretan village of **Arhanes**.



The archaeological site of Knossos is sited 5 km southeast of the city of Heraklion. There is evidence that this location was inhabited during the neolithic times (6000 B.C.) . On the ruins of the neolithic settlement was built the first Minoan palace (1900 B.C.) where the dynasty of Minos ruled. The Palace of Knossos is the largest of the preserved Minoan palatial centres. Four wings are arranged around a central courtyard, containing the royal quarters, workshops, shrines, storerooms, repositories, the throne room and banquet halls. Dated to 2000-1350 B.C. The palace covered an area of 22,000 sq.m, it was multi- storeyed and had an intricate plan. Due to this fact the Palace is connected with

thrilling legends, such as the myth of the Labyrinth with the Minotaur. Between 1.700-1.450 BC, the Minoan civilisation was at its peak and Knossos was the most important city-state.



The Arhanes village lies in the Temenos Region, just 15 kilometers from Heraklion and its inhabitation has been documented for over 5000 years. According to history, King Minos had a summer palace in the Arhanes village. Arhanes boasts beautiful mountains and neoclassical buildings, and is a beautifully preserved and protected village. Arhanes is a very important Minoan site, and contains several Byzantine Churches

Day 4

Saturday 23rd June 2012

The Saturday Dinner Gala (21:00) will take place at the **“Minotaure”** Restaurant at St Nicolas Bay Resort.



The “Minotaure” next to the Pool is an exclusive place for the intimate candlelight dinner under the stars. The Gala dinner is planned to be a gastronomic event that caters for all eating preferences, including Asian and International innovative cuisine plus a selection of exquisite Greek wines.
